  4. Exodus 3:1–17 (Moses—I AM)
  5. Exodus 13:20—14:30 (God parts the Red Sea)
  6. Exodus 20:1–17 (the Ten Commandments)
  7. Judges 2:11–19 (God sends judges)
  8. 1 Samuel 8:1–22 (the people ask for a king)
  9. 1 Samuel 16:1–3, 8–13 (David is made a king)
  10. 2 Kings 25:1–12 (destruction of the Temple)
  11. Psalm 23:1–6 (The Lord is Our Shepherd)
  12. Wisdom 6:1–11 (the responsibility of rulers)
  13. Jeremiah 1:4–10 (call of the prophet Jeremiah)
  14. Isaiah 52:13, 53:4–11 (God's Suffering Servant)
