Advocate: The Holy Spirit as intercessor, comforter, consoler, and teacher who represents the continued presence of Jesus on earth; paraclete.

agape: The unconditional love that God has for us.

Beloved Disciple: A mysterious person found in John's Gospel who traditionally has been identified as the Apostle John. Today he is thought to be another disciple who founded the Christian community that produced the Gospel of John.

Book of Glory: The second part of the Gospel of John, which contains the dialogue between Jesus and his disciples at the Last Supper as well as the story of his death and Resurrection.

Book of Signs: The first part of the Gospel of John, which contains seven miracle accounts.

I AM: "I AM WHO AM" was the personal name of God that was revealed to Moses at the burning bush (see Exodus 3:14). The New Testament connects this title with Jesus.

Logos: The Greek translation of Word; Jesus.

Word of God, the: A title that describes the divine nature of Christ.
