You are under pressure to decide right away (within the next few moments) which option seems right for you. Under each option, list reasons for selecting it. Then put a star next to the one option that seems of most immediate importance. Be prepared to explain why this option is most important.

- Proclaim on the streets and in the synagogues that Jesus is the Christ; encourage others to repent, believe in him, and be baptized.
- **4** Go to an isolated place to pray and to sort out the meaning of the last two years.

- **2** Go to those who are afflicted or poor and comfort and care for them.
- **6** Record immediately as much detail about the life of Jesus and his followers as you can.

- **3** Organize people who share your belief in lesus into communities to consider action.
- **6** Organize classes to teach about the lessons you have learned from Jesus.
