## **Chapter Learning Objectives**

- The participants will explore ways God has guided humanity through a number of events in salvation history.
- The participants will examine the Bible to see examples of people chosen by God to do his will.
- The participants will reflect on how they participate in salvation history.

## **Content Summary**

- 1. Salvation history is the pattern of events through which God reveals himself and his saving actions to us.
- 2. Salvation history can be divided into eight stages—six stages found in the Old Testament, and two stages found in the New Testament.
- 3. The Old Testament stages are the following: (1) primeval history, (2) the patriarchs, (3) Egypt and the Exodus, (4) the Promised Land and the judges, (5) the kings and the prophets, and (6) the Exile and the return.
- 4. The New Testament stages are the following: (7) the life of Jesus Christ and (8) the Church.
- 5. The final stage of salvation history continues today through the Church.
- 6. The Church will continue to share the Gospel until the end of time.
- 7. We, as members of the Church and with the help of the Holy Spirit, take part in Christ's mission today.
