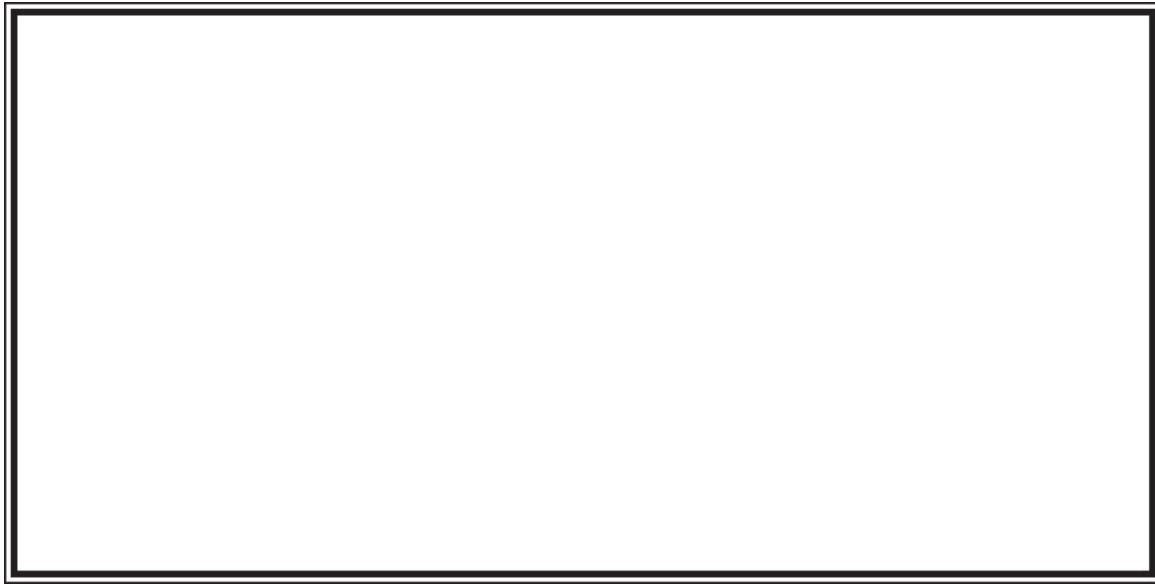


## Chapter 16 Activity: Symbols of the Resurrection
