

## Podcasts on Prayer

Imagine that your bishop has invited you to create a series of teen-friendly podcasts about prayer that will be posted on the diocesan Web site. He has asked you and your team to create three podcasts, each 5 minutes long, dealing with various topics related to prayer.

Your series of podcasts must contain or demonstrate the following:

- understanding of the following four concepts
  - Through prayer we experience the grace of the Paschal Mystery and grow in our relationship with God.
  - Prayer can take many forms and expressions (give examples).
  - The Church's liturgy is a form of public prayer that makes the Paschal Mystery available to us today.
  - The liturgies of the Easter Triduum are a special opportunity for us to meditate on God's saving plan, culminating in the Paschal Mystery.
- creative reflection on these main concepts that blends theoretical and practical questions regarding prayer
- podcasts that are appropriate and reflect the maturity and substance of a high school religious studies course
