The Cycle of Judges

- The Israelites worship other gods.
- God becomes angry and gives the Israelites over to the power of their enemies.
- The Israelites cry out to God.
- God raises up a judge to deliver the Israelites.
- The judge frees the Israelites from their enemies.
- The land has rest while the judge lives.
- The judge dies and the cycle begins again.
