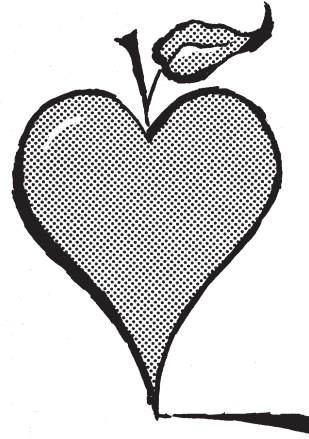


# Attitudes About Sexuality
