

Jesus Is Alive! Alleluia!

A cinquain (sin-kane) is a five-line poem that has this structure:

1. One word telling the subject of the poem
2. Two words describing the word in the first line
3. Three "ing" action words about the topic
4. Four words that express a feeling or thought
5. A synonym for the first word



Here is an example:

Christmas
Joyful, holy
Praising, singing, laughing
Earth has a Savior
Birth

Read Mark 16:1–6, and write a cinquain about the Resurrection of Jesus.
