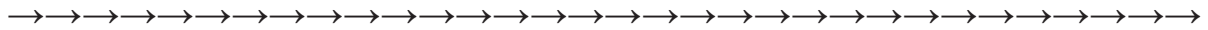


Path B: Union with _____
