**shepherd** someone who takes care of sheep

**rod** short, heavy stick

**staff** hooked stick used to guide sheep

**banquet** a large meal or a feast



## Understand It!

You have probably never seen a shepherd. A shepherd guides sheep to food and water. He makes sure that the sheep stay away from cliffs and thorns. He protects them from wolves and other dangerous animals. At night the shepherd counts his sheep and finds any sheep that are missing.

A shepherd is a sheep's best friend because he keeps the sheep safe and cares for their needs. In this prayer from Psalm 23, we call God our shepherd because he is our guide and protector. He gives us food and everything we need. He shows us the right way to live. Wouldn't you agree that God is our best friend?
