Passages	Example of Moral Teaching	Value for Today
<b>Romans 12:9–21</b>	General guidelines for moral living	Provides advice for living a peaceful, fulfilling life
<b>Romans 13:1–7</b>	Respecting civil authority	Promotes respect for those in positions of authority; the purpose of a person in authority is to do God's will, upholding what is good and right, and correcting what is evil and wrong
<b>Romans 14:13–23</b>	Whether to eat meat sacrificed to idols	Describes how to live in community with those of different faiths
<b>Ephesians 4:17–5:5</b>	What it means to live according to the New Law	Provides examples of how to live a new life in Christ; provides guidelines for living a Christian life
<b>Ephesians 5:21–6:4</b>	Guidelines for family life	Promotes respect between husbands and wives; promotes children obeying and respecting parents
<b>Colossians 3:5–17</b>	Vices to avoid and virtues to practice	Provides advice for how to live a life in harmony with others and with ourselves
