Essay

Responses will vary but should include some of the following points:

- A. What is the First Commandment, and what does it call us to do?
The First Commandment is: I am the Lord, your God: you shall not have strange gods before me. It calls us to have faith in God, to put our hope in him, and to love him completely without holding back anything.
- B. What are some examples of promises or vows that Catholics make in the sacraments?
Answers might include that in the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, we promise to reject Satan and all his works and empty promises; in the Sacrament of Matrimony, the bride and groom promise to be true to each other until death, no matter what happens; in the Sacrament of Holy Orders, a man being ordained to the priesthood makes promises of celibacy and obedience to his bishop.
- C. Create a list of five ways families may keep Sundays holy.
Families may keep Sundays holy by attending Mass with a sense of gratitude for God's blessings, spending some time reading and talking about the Sunday Scriptures, enjoying leisure time together, visiting friends and relatives, preparing and sharing family meals, or doing acts of charity.
