Essay

A. What does it mean to honor parents?

- The Church teaches that the attitudes that children owe parents are respect, gratitude, obedience, and assistance. Children are to show respect for their parents even when they disagree with them. They are to be grateful for the support and sacrifices their parents make for them. They are to obey their parent's direction and requests unless they are asked to do something immoral. And they are to assist their parents with family work and responsibilities.

B. What can we say about God's will in respect to truth in the media?

- It is God's will that media outlets be sources for truth and moral entertainment. Society has the right for information based in truth that promotes human freedom and that calls society to act justly. Society also has the responsibility to see that the media provide such information.

C. What are three responsibilities that companies and employers have in light of the Seventh Commandment?

- Answers might include the following. First, they have the responsibility to make sure the goods and services they provide contribute to the good of society and not to its harm. Second, they must be sure their manufacturing processes do not harm the workers or the environment. Third, they have the responsibility to provide their workers with a fair and just wage and benefits. Fourth, they must not practice discrimination in their hiring practices. Last, they must not ask their employees to do anything immoral or illegal.
