Introduce Isaiah on page 908 of the Bible and the Book of Isaiah on page 1151.

- Visit the sidebar articles throughout the Book of Isaiah. Note the Catholic Connection article on page 917 about Mary's "Yes" and on page 947 about the Church's seasons.
- Also see the Challenge on page 920 to prepare for Christmas. Isaiah foretells the coming of a faithful, suffering servant.
- Read the "Who Is My Neighbor" article on page 957 about the servant's mission.

 Challenge yourself to read 2-3 of the short chapters in Isaiah, each day, during Advent-from Nov. 29-December 24 to prepare your heart and your life for Jesus.

The First Reading on Dec. 6th is Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11.

• Go to YouTube to find and listen to "Comfort Ye," from Handel's Messiah, to pray along with it.

Do the activity for Isaiah, chapter 61 (found on page 147 of The Catholic Youth Bible Activity Book) to prepare for Mass prior to December 20th, where a passage from this chapter will be proclaimed.
