

4 EASY STEPS TO CONNECTING WITH KIDS VIA VIDEO



1. Begin with a personal check-in with children. (5 minutes)

Ask them questions about how they're doing—fun things, new things, challenging things, what they are looking forward to and hoping for.



2. Review their responses in the eLearning chapters. (10 minutes)

Briefly revisit or review the Scripture story and the doctrine of the chapter. Create a discussion, not a lecture or a "teaching," as it's already been done. Use the questions and points provided in your Catechist Guide to help guide the discussion. (If using Discover!, these can be found under the "Dive In" and "Discover" sections of the chapter.)



3. Do something fun that is video-call friendly. (10 minutes)

Relate the active learning game to the chapter/concept of faith (e.g., show and tell, a scavenger hunt)



4. Pray together, making it a meaningful experience. (5 minutes)
