Matthew 5:43–48 (on loving your enemies)
Paraphrase:
Who is Jesus referring to when he uses the word <i>enemy</i> ?
Why is love of enemies and not just friends essential to true unity?
Mark 12:28–34 (the Greatest Commandment: love God and neighbor) Paraphrase:
Who is Jesus talking about when he uses the word neighbor?
Why is love of all people, no matter how diverse they are, essential to unity?

John 15:12–17 (Jesus' command: to love one another)
Paraphrase:
What connection does Jesus make between love and self-sacrifice?
How can love, as described by Jesus, create unity?
1 Corinthians 13:1–13 (the greatest gift is love)
Paraphrase:
Which of the qualities of love described in 1 Corinthians, chapter 13, do you think contributes most toward unity among people?
What did you learn from these scriptural statements about the meaning of unity or oneness as a Mark of the Church?
